We found another location to go to this year that we think will be just as fun as last year. We've decided to do a couple of things different this year. First we won't be doing anything with Coalville like we have in the past. We will just be spending the three days in the mountains and not going down an oil road at all. We've decided to go to the camp site on the first day and just making a base camp and spend two nights at the one location. The second day we will have the option of going on a good day ride or you can just lounge around in camp. Your choice!! There are some good trails that we can go on and give the horses a good workout and see some beautiful country. That will do away with the vehicle shuttle for one day. On Saturday we will come back to the same place we left from but come down a different trail. The dates will be, June 9th, 10th, and 11th. That is Thursday, Friday and Saturday. There will be a place to camp on Wednesday night if you want to come then so you wont have to get up so early on Thursday.
